## **Protective Grazing Heights for Dominant Forage Species**

The following grazing heights should be maintained for native and introduced grasses where grazing is the principle method of harvest. Monitor grasses before, during, and after grazing cycles.



Use a grazing stick or ruler to monitor grass growth.
